



Leaders act weakly in global climate crisis

Due to climate change and the increasing amount of disasters hitting the planet there is an immediate need to execute a global emergency response plan. All countries will be affected in some way and now more than ever mankind will be put to the test. Leaders of the world's countries are showing nothing but weakness in relation to the crucial decisions that must be made and executed in order to minimize the effects of the already growing number of catastrophes. Actions that need immediate attention on a global level are:
